GEOSIGHT Privacy Policy

Issue 1 – 01/2022

1. Introduction

GEOSIGHT Ltd. (“us”, “we”, or “our”) provides survey services, operates <https://www.geosight3d.com> and any other related GEOSIGHT sites from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “**Service**”).

Our Privacy Policy governs your visit to <https://www.geosight3d.com> and the use of our survey services, and explains how we collect, safeguard and disclose information that results from your use of our Service.

We use your data to provide and improve our Service. By using our Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, the terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions.

Our Terms and Conditions (“**Terms**”) govern all use of our Service and together with the Privacy Policy constitutes your agreement with us (“**Agreement**”).

2. Definitions

SERVICE means the <https://www.geosight3d.com> website, and the various survey services provided by GEOSIGHT Ltd.

PERSONAL DATA means data about a living individual who can be identified from that data (or from those and other information either in our possession or likely to come into our possession).

USAGE DATA is data collected automatically either generated by the use of Service or from Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

COOKIES are small files stored on your device (computer or mobile device).

DATA CONTROLLER means a natural or legal person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal data are, or are to be, processed. For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, we are a Data Controller of your data.

DATA PROCESSORS (OR SERVICE PROVIDERS) means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller. We may use the services of various Service Providers in order to process your data more effectively.

DATA SUBJECT is any living individual who is the subject of Personal Data.

Privacy Policy

THE USER is the individual using our Service. The User corresponds to the Data Subject, who is the subject of Personal Data.

3. Information Collection and Use

We collect several different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our Service to you. Primarily your name(s) and your contact address, and the address where our Service may be executed.

4. Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you (“**Personal Data**”). Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- (a) Email address
- (b) First name and last name
- (c) Phone number
- (d) Address

This data will be used for the purposes of your project survey administration only. We will not use your Personal Data to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information. This data will not be passed to any third party for any purpose other than the execution of your survey project.

Other Data

While using our Service we may also collect the following information: place of residence, survey location, telephone number (work, mobile), details of documents relating to properties or vessels, non-disclosure agreements, office location and other data.

5. Use of Data

GEOSIGHT Ltd. uses the collected data for various purposes:

- (a) to provide and maintain our Service;
- (b) to notify you about changes to our Service during the contract period;
- (c) to provide customer support;
- (e) to gather analysis so that we can improve our Service;
- (f) to monitor the usage of our Service;
- (g) to detect, prevent and address technical issues;
- (h) to fulfil any other purpose for which you provide it;
- (i) to carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection;
- (j) to provide you with notices about your contract;
- (k) in any other way we may describe when you provide the information;
- (l) for any other purpose with your consent.

6. Retention of Data

We will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, typically 6 years. We will retain and use your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

7. Transfer of Data

Your information, including Personal Data, may be transferred to – and maintained on – computers located outside of your country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those of your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

GEOSIGHT Ltd. will take all the steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of your data and other personal information.

8. Disclosure of Data

We may disclose personal information that we collect, or you provide:

(a) Disclosure for Law Enforcement:

Under certain circumstances, we may be required to disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities.

(b) Business Transaction.

If we are involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, your Personal Data may be transferred.

(c) Other cases. We may disclose your information also:

- (i) to contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business;
- (ii) to fulfil the purpose for which you provide it;
- (iii) for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information;
- (iv) with your consent in any other cases;
- (v) if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others.

9. Security of Data

The security of your data is important to us but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

10. Your Data Protection Rights Under General Data Protection

Regulation (GDPR)

- (f) the right to withdraw consent. You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time where we rely on your consent to process your personal information;

Please note that we may ask you to verify your identity before responding to such requests. Please note we may not be able to provide our Service without some necessary data.

You have the right to complain to a Data Protection Authority about our collection and use of your Personal Data. For more information, please contact your local data protection authority in the European Economic Area (EEA).

11. Your Data Protection Rights

We agree to the following:
